**DOGS ELIGIBLE TO ENTER**

Dogs who are at least nine (9) months of age are eligible to take the FDC and must either be AKC or FSS registered, enrolled in the AKC Canine Partners Program, or have a Purebred Alternative Listing number. Dogs who are spayed or neutered may participate. Dogs with disabilities (e.g., blind, deaf, three legs) are eligible to enter provided in the opinion of the judge they display no signs of physical discomfort and can safely complete the test.

Bitches in season are eligible to participate; they will be tested at the end. Dogs with bandages, sutures, or visible wounds are not eligible.

## ENTRY FEES

Each dog may be entered once in each test.

No entries will be accepted by phone, email, or fax. Express mail entries must include the signature waiver allowing them to be left at the secretary's address. No entry shall be made or accepted which specifies any conditions as to its acceptance.

**Illegible entries** will not be processed and will be returned to the exhibitor. Returned checks do not constitute a valid entry and the Test Secretary will add a \$25.00 collection fee to the amount of each returned check.

## ATTENTION EXHIBITORS!

- **LIMITED ENTRY** – 25 dogs per test (75 dogs total per weekend). Entries will be processed in the order received.
- **FEES MUST ACCOMPANY ENTRIES.** This Club and/or Test Secretary assume no responsibility for incomplete or wrong information on the entry form, or for a dog being entered in a test for which the dog is not eligible to compete.
- **SIGN IN AS SOON AS YOU ARRIVE TO MINIMIZE DELAYS.**
- **CRATING SPACE** Please plan to crate from your vehicle.
- **SCHEDULING.** Exhibitors will be scheduled in 10-minute blocks. Plan on arriving at least 30 minutes before your test time. Check in when you arrive; we will do our best to accommodate scheduling change requests. We may run in small groups if possible.
- **NOTICE.** The American Kennel Club Rules & Regulations will govern this event and exhibitors must make themselves familiar with the agreement on the reverse side of the official American Kennel Club Entry Form which is a part of this Premium List.

## ADDITIONAL TEST INFORMATION

Exhibitors are responsible for cleaning up after their dog(s). Any exhibitor failing to do so may be excused without benefit of refund if the Event Committee deems the exhibitor to be in violation of this requirement.

**FDC PROCEDURES.** All exhibitors should familiarize themselves with the procedures and requirements for the FDC. Download the “Farm Dog Certified Test Guide” at <https://www.akc.org/sports/herding/farm-dog-certified-test/>. A video of an FDC test in action may also be found at that site.

**SAFETY, BEHAVIOR, AND LIABILITY.** The safety of the dog and farm livestock is our primary concern. By entering this test, exhibitors acknowledge that they are familiar with the rules and regulations of the FDC test, and that their dogs are familiar with and able to perform all exercises safely. It is expressly understood that exhibitors alone are responsible for the behavior of their dogs. Any exhibitor whose dogs create an unnecessary disturbance or repeatedly engage in unsafe or disruptive behavior will be asked to leave the test site. In such case, no refund of any fees paid will be made. The Columbia Basin Dog Training Club (CBDTC) and its agents, employees, etc., will assume no responsibilities for any loss, damage or injury sustained by exhibitors or any of their dogs or property. CBDTC reserves the right to decline entries for cause and may remove any dog on account of aggression. No one shall have any recourse or claim against CBDTC or any official thereof.

**COLLARS AND LEASHES.** During testing, dogs must wear a secure, well-fitting flat collar. They may not wear prong collars, head collars, e-collars, or harnesses that restrict the movement of the dog. Leashes should be 4 ft. to 6 ft. long and made of fabric or leather.

All dogs must be on leash at all times, and retractable leashes may not be used when on test grounds. Dogs must enter and exit the testing area with the leash attached to the collar, including when waiting in the wait area before and after the test.

**REFUNDS.** No entry fee will be refunded if the test cannot open or be completed by reason of riots, civil disturbances, fire, an act of God, public emergency, act of a public enemy, or any other cause beyond the control of the organizing committee. No entry fee will be refunded in the event a dog is absent, disqualified, excused, or barred from evaluation by the action of the Event Committee. Dogs pulled after closing because of injury or other medical condition are not eligible for a refund. **Claims will be arbitrated as set forth on the Official AKC Entry Form for this event.**

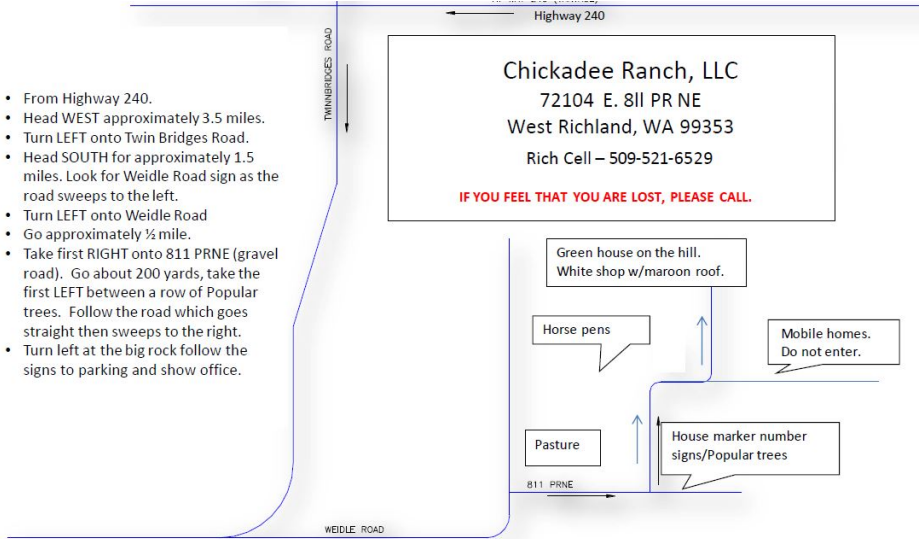
Exhibitors should follow their veterinarian’s recommendation to assure their dogs are free of internal and external parasites, any communicable diseases, and have appropriate vaccinations.

I certify that I am the actual owner of the dog, or that I am the duly authorized agent of the actual owner whose name I have entered. In consideration of the acceptance of this entry, I (we) agree to abide by the rules and regulations of The American Kennel Club in effect at the time of this event, and any additional rules and regulations appearing in the premium list of this event and entry form and any decision made in accord with them. I (we) agree that the club holding this event has the right to refuse this entry for cause which the club shall deem sufficient. I (we) certify and represent that the dog entered is not a hazard to persons or other dogs. In consideration of the acceptance of this entry and of the holding of this event and of the opportunity to have the dog judged and to win prizes, ribbons, or trophies, I (we) agree to hold the AKC, the event-giving club, their members, directors, governors, officers, agents, superintendents or event secretary and the owner and/or lessor of the premises and any provider of services that are necessary to hold this event and any employees or volunteers of the aforementioned parties, and any AKC approved judge, judging at this event, harmless from any claim for loss or injury which may be alleged to have been caused directly or indirectly to any person or thing by the act of this dog while in or about the event premises or grounds or near any entrance thereto, and I (we) personally assume all responsibility and liability for any such claim; and I (we) further agree to hold the aforementioned parties harmless from any claim of loss, injury or damage to this dog.

Additionally, I (we) hereby assume the sole responsibility for and agree to indemnify, defend and save the aforementioned parties harmless from any and all loss and expense (including legal fees) by reason of the liability imposed by law upon any of the aforementioned parties for damage because of bodily injuries, including death at any time resulting therefrom, sustained by any person or persons, including myself (ourselves), or on account of damage to property, arising out of or in consequence of my (our) participation in this event, however such, injuries death or property damage may be caused, and whether or not the same may have been caused or may be alleged to have been caused by the negligence of the aforementioned parties or any of their employees, agents, or any other person.
